NCAA NOTES:

- Florida has reached the semifinals of the NCAA Championship 14 times in the last 15 years, including eight trips to the national championship final.
- In 1996, Florida became only the second team in NCAA women's tennis history to sweep the team, singles and doubles titles.
- Florida was the first of only two schools in NCAA women's tennis history to produce both the NCAA singles champion and finalist in the same year. Shaun Stafford defeated teammate Halle Cioffi in the finals of the 1988 championship.
